Sub: Notice Inviting Tender for the supply of a Therapeutic (Massage) Chair

Sealed tenders in two parts (Technical and Financial separately) are invited from manufacturers/authorized dealers, who have supplied Gym equipment for International Organizations/Government Departments/Five Star Hotels, for the supply of one Therapeutic (Massage) Chair with exquisite craftsmanship, intuitive remote control, automatic foot rest adjustment, robotic technology, smooth recline, foot reflexology, acupuncture point detection operation able on 230 volt \pm 10% volts single phase, 50 Hz AC supply with following additional specifications/features: -

1. 3D massage experience
2. Triple massage actions (Rolling/Airbag/Vibration)
3. Upper body massage (Kneading/Reverse/Tapping/Rolling)
4. Lower body massage (Seat/Calf/Foot)
5. Reclining Angle : 120 to 170 degree
6. Upholstery: Synthetic Leather (Anti bacterial, Anti dirt)
7. Automatic Programmes: 10 or more
8. Timer: Auto
9. Manual Programme: 6 or more
10. Sensor: Optical

2. The **Technical bid** should contain the company profile, a copy of authorization letter from the manufacturer, Sales Tax Number and specifications of the equipment, details of trademark of the equipment, list of clients and Performance Certificates/Undertakings from at least three Government Departments/Five Star Hotels in token of satisfactory completion of similar nature of supplies, the warranty of the equipment (should be from the parent company), Earnest Money Deposit, Tax Identification Certificate and any other relevant document, which the firm wishes to submit. The **Financial bid** should contain the rates of the equipment and taxes, if any. Those bids that do not qualify the pre-qualification conditions shall be summarily rejected and their financial bid shall not be opened. The bids in separate sealed covers

superscribed "Technical Bid for Therapeutic (Massage) Chair" and "Financial Bid for Therapeutic (Massage) Chair" addressed to the Deputy Secretary (K), President's Secretariat, Rashtrapati Bhavan, New Delhi-110 004 should be dropped in the tender box placed at the Central Registry Section, Rashtrapati Bhavan, near Brassey Avenue, Opposite Cathedral Church, New Delhi on all working days between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.. The last date for dropping the bids is 3rd March 08. Incomplete bid document will not be accepted. Late submission of tenders will also not be accepted. The tenders will be opened on 5th March 08 at 3.30 pm by a Board in the presence of the tenderers or their representatives who desire to remain present at that time.

3. An earnest money of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) shall be deposited by the firm in the form of an Account payee Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, President's Secretariat, New Delhi. The earnest money of the firms, whose quotations are not approved, will be refunded as quickly as possible.


Terms & Conditions

1. Material shall have to be supplied and installed at Rashtrapati Bhavan 'Health Centre' at no extra cost.
 2. Firm should indicate guarantee/warranty period for the product.
 3. No advance payment shall be made.
 4. Firms shall have to arrange for demonstration/installation at no extra cost.
 5. Material shall have to be supplied within one month of placement of order.
 6. The successful bidder shall be required to make performance security deposit of Rs.25,000/-. This amount will be refundable after one year of the successful installation/operation of the equipment.
 7. 90% of the payment of supply of equipment will be released after receipt and installation of the equipment. The balance amount will be released after successful operation of the equipment.
 8. During warranty period necessary maintenance shall be carried out free of cost.
 9. Supplier should indicate make & model of the equipment.
4. In the event of breach of any terms or conditions of the agreement by the successful bidder, the Secretary to the President reserves the right to annul the agreement

and have the supply arranged at the supplier's risk and expense without any further notice to him. The supplier will have no claim to compensation for any loss, which he suffers, in any case of default of contracted terms. For any default on the part of the supplier, his performance security deposit will be forfeited either in full or proportionately as may be required.

5. The Secretary to the President reserves the right to accept or reject any bid in whole or in part without assigning any reason thereof.
